Welcome to the CKP's production of Frozen Jr! Performing in a musical is an experience that you child will remember for the rest of their lives, and it is truly our pleasure to work with you and your child on this exciting project. We want everyone involved to understand both the benefits and responsibilities that go along with being in a musical, so we have detailed some of the basics here.

As with any group activity, every participant has responsibilities. Please look over the following items to make sure you and your family can honor the commitment to being a part of a show.

Auditions: Everyone will be accepted. A line read and singing audition will be held for main character during the first week of rehearsals. Audition song: "Love Is an Open Door". Actors will read from the script on Monday and Tuesday sing on Wednesday & Thursday (we will review the song on Monday). Participants have the choice to audition solo or in a group. Both days are important, please let us know if you have a conflict.

Attendance: Attached to this letter is a basic rehearsal schedule for the show. Please look it over closely to make sure your child has no conflicts with the rehearsals or show dates. If there are conflicts, please let the production team know as soon as possible. A more detailed calendar will be given the second week. Students are expected to attend all rehearsals they are called for unless prior approval has been given. Failure to do so can result in dismissal from the show.

Rehearsals: <u>Rehearsals start January 7. 2019</u>. Rehearsals are *4pm to 6pm, every Monday and Wednesdays* at the Selma Arts Center. We may call some <u>Friday's</u> rehearsals for Main Characters so please look to the detailed calendar. Students should bring their scripts, a pencil, water, and wear appropriate shoes and clothes for movement. Also, please make sure you have arranged to be picked up on time from each rehearsal.

Notices: All handouts, calendars and forms will be downloadable online at <u>www.selmaartscenter.com/youth</u>. Please check the "Parent Spot" on the website Youth page weekly for updates. All show promotions and fun things will be posted on our CKP Facebook <u>www.facebook.com/CKP.Selma</u>

Homework: Your child will be given a scripts and CD that is theirs to keep. Actors must bring scripts to every rehearsal. Actors will have some homework for the show, including memorizing lines and songs, rehearsing their dances, researching their character, etc. Create a schedule so you have time to finish homework from the musical that does not conflict with schoolwork

Attitude: The rehearsal room and theater are safe spaces where people can take positive risks and be themselves without the fear of being laughed at or alienated. This principle is essential to artistic growth and exploration. Participants are expected to respect these principles and are encouraged to remember it themselves when trying new things.

Volunteering: Please list on the registration form your name and phone/email if you are interested in volunteering time or resources to the production. Supervising, sewing and craft making are always in need. If you are not ready to commit, a Volunteer Sign-up sheet for performances will be posted in the lobby a week before show time. <u>Parent supervision during performances is essential.</u>

Performances: Performances are Thursday, February 28th at 7PM / Friday, March 1st at 7PM /Saturday, March 2rd at 2PM & 7PM. If we have a high volume of participants we will add two more shows on Sunday, March 3th, 2PM & 7PM. Actors will have "call times" (the time they need to be there) 1 hour before show time Call time is very important for schedule. Again, Parent Supervision is greatly needed during performances.

Costumes: All Actors must provide their own make up and shoes. Most Actors will come dressed for Dress Rehearsals and Performances. Costumes will be handed out and discussed two weeks before performances. Actors may be asked to provide small items of their costume (exp. Long sleeve undershirts, leggings, tights)

Finally, please remember a musical is a living, breathing entity. Things don't always go exactly as planned, so changes in the plan will be made throughout the rehearsal process. We promise to give you as much advanced notice as possible on all changes that arise.
