Staff Report

Meeting Date: September 10th, 2020

Administrative Matters: A report on any communications that staff has received will be discussed at the meeting. Followed by any Public Comment.

Business: Arts Council - Agenda Items:

- 1. The monthly Financial Report will be provided and discussed.
- 2. The committee will report on the ongoing progress and budget for a three weekend Drive-In Movie event .The council is co-producing the event with Selma Chamber of Commerce. Tickets are on-sale and sponsors are currently being collected. The deadline for sponsors is September 10th.
- 3. Member Claudio Laso will report on submissions for Selma Originals and the timeline of events. Scrips have been selected and performances have been scheduled for October 16th & 17th.
- 4. Update on current and future online events. "Tiny Stage" is in progress thanks to Members Adrian Oceguera & Jose Moreno. Both will report on acts filming this month
- 5. The Council will discuss the function and criteria of committees including an Actor Relation Committee. The council would like to extend the opportunity of running a committee to Alexis Macedo. Discussion on what committee she will be assigned and what her responsibilities would be.
- 6. Choreographer Michael Floras has offered to organize and direct a family show for Halloween that is available to stream. Captain Louie is based on the children's book, The Trip by Ezra Jack Keats, and is a Halloween centered story created for young audiences. The Jr. show currently allows adults to be cast; it is affordable and includes tracks. Michael has produced the production previously and will be able to produce the show in a short amount of time. The cast is a total of 7 people and will be filmed and streamed. Actors will social distance and wear masks during rehearsals.
- 7. Member Ben Deghand, and committee, will discuss the updated plan for an Online Talent Show scheduled to air in November.
