<u>Auditions:</u> Please submit an online Audition Form before signing up for an audition appointment. Performers are encouraged to make an appointment via Sign Up Genius (). All auditions and callbacks will be held in person at the Selma Arts Center. Those without an appointment will be seen on a walk-in basis, as time permits.

For your audition, please prepare the following:

1) 16-32 bars of a musical selection. You must have sheet music for the accompanist or a karaoke track prepared. *Note from the Director: Modern and Pop/Rock song choices are encouraged.*

<u>CDC Guidelines:</u> Unvaccinated patrons must wear masks inside the theatre at all times. Masks do not have to be worn inside the theatre if you have been fully vaccinated. Participants are encouraged to wash hands before and after rehearsals.

<u>Video Auditions:</u> If you are unable to make the general auditions (we strongly recommend an in person audition), an accompanied video recording of the required materials specified above may be submitted **before August 3, 2021 at 8:00 PM** via the Audition Registration Form or email to <u>nicolettea@cityofselma.com</u>. Please list a via unlisted YouTube link on the online Audition Registration Form. However, you MUST attend the mandatory callback (should you be called back) on Wednesday, August 4, 2021 at 6:30 PM in order to be considered for a role. If this is not possible, please email <u>nicolettea@cityofselma.com</u> with any questions or concerns.

<u>Callbacks</u>: Callbacks will include a singing and reading round, as well as a choreography round, unless the role does not call for it. Please dress appropriately - a change of clothes is encouraged.

- Due to the tight rehearsal schedule, all conflicts must be presented during your auditions.

Conflicts presented after the first rehearsal will not be honored. Please note that excessive conflicts will affect casting decisions.

- Casting notification will occur no later than Saturday, August 7, 2021.
- Extra private music rehearsals may be called for principal roles. Should you be cast, you will be contacted by the vocal director for your availability and scheduling.

- Performances: September 24, 25, 26, 30, October 1, 2 & 3 for a total of 8 performances, including double-shows on each Saturday. The show runs for a total of two weekends. Matinee performances are scheduled for September 25 & October 2. All evening performances begin at 7:30pm and matinee performances begin at 2:00pm.

Synopsis: Based on the popular Disney Channel Original Movies, Disney's *Descendants: The Musical* is a brand-new musical comedy featuring the beloved characters and hit songs from the films!

Carlos: Cruella de Vil's son. Despite a fear of dogs and just about everything else, he has the capacity to be brave and kind.

Maleficent: The infamous evil fairy. She is a profoundly selfish absentee parent with an unquenchable taste for vengeance.

Grimhilde: Snow White's wicked adversary. An aging beauty queen, she is still desperate to be the fairest of them all.

Jafar: Aladdin's nemesis. He is a slimy, washed-up crime lord desperate for a way back to the top.

Vocal range bottom: B2

Cruella de Vil: A Dalmatian-loving dog-snatcher. She is an obsessive, eccentric, and overbearing helicopter mom

Vocal range top: B4 Vocal range bottom: B3

Ben: Son of the Beast and Belle. He is a classically regal, optimistic kid who bears the weight of soon becoming King of Auradon.

Vocal range top: Bb4
Vocal range bottom: Ab2

King Beast: Ben's father and King of Auradon. Royal and rule-driven, he knows a bit about being marginalized.

Gender: Male

Queen Belle: Ben's mother and Queen of Auradon. Warm, but cautious, she doesn't understand her son's generation.

Fairy Godmother: Headmistress of Auradon Prep. Busy and bubbly, she'll do anything to keep the school afloat.

Vocal range top: D5 Vocal range bottom: D4

Jane: Fairy Godmother's daughter. Meek and mousy, but hungry for attention, she's looking for her moment to shine.

Vocal range top: D5 Vocal range bottom: E4

Chad: Cinderella and Prince Charming's son. An arrogant and spoiled blockhead, he's never wanted for anything.

Vocal range top: D4 Vocal range bottom: B2

Audrey: Sleeping Beauty's daughter. The malicious queen bee of Auradon Prep, she has her eye on the throne.

Vocal range top: B4 Vocal range bottom: A3 **Doug**: Dopey's son. Nerdy and sweet, he does all the work that his fellow students don't

want to do.

Vocal range top: E4
Vocal range bottom: C4

Royal Page: Auradonian messenger, enormously nervous.

Royal Guard: Museum employee, less than vigilant.

Maurice: Chemistry teacher and Belle's father. He is kooky and stuck in his ways.

Coach: Tourney coach, resigned to the team's mediocrity until meeting a surprise star player.

Snow White: Red carpet reporter. She is the voice of the masses.

Ensemble: Roles include: Isle Ensemble (including Smitten Kids 1 & 2), Auradonians (including Auradonians 1 & 2), Coronation Crowd (including Crowd Members 1, 2 & 3), Auradonian Choir
