Administrative Matters: A report on any communications that staff has received will be discussed at the meeting. Followed by any Public Comment.

Business: Arts Council - Agenda Items:

1. The monthly Financial Report will be provided and discussed.
2. Arts Center Coordinator, Nicolette Andersen will give an update on the postponement of “SpongeBob the Musical” including an updated budget. Sponsors and a fundraiser will be planned to help recover costs and reopen in the summer.
3. An update will be given on “Little Shop of Horrors,” Performances are March 18th – April 2nd
4. Arts Council Vice Chair, Juan Guzman will report on El Centro- Hispanic and Latinex Cultural and Community Center at Virginia Tech Zoot Suit Screening and Talkback. El Centro has reached out about the possibility of screening the Selma Arts Center’s production of Zoot Suit and inviting members of the cast to Zoom in for a talkback. They are offering a \$500 stipend to the Selma Arts Center.
5. Arts Council Members Adrian Ocegüera will give an update on the spring fundraiser. Tejano Baile for the Arts is a fundraiser concert featuring hot local talent in the Tejano community. The fundraiser will require a street closer for a stage located on High Street, a dance floor, food truck vendors and beer garden. The event will also require council and volunteer support.
