<u>Auditions:</u> Please submit an online Audition Form before signing up for an audition appointment. Actors 8-12 are encouraged to come at the 6:30pm- 7:30pm times slot. Those without an appointment will be seen as time permits.

<u>Actors 8-12</u>- Actors 8-12 are welcome to come prepared with the provided song listed on the audition page. Links will be posted with tracks and sheet music available on the audition page www.selmaartscenter.com/audition. A copy of the sheet music and tracks will be available at the audition.

<u>All Other Ages</u>, please prepare approximately 16-32 bars of music in the style of the show. **Tracks are encouraged** and a bluetooth speaker will be provided. Those interested in auditioning for *Matilda* MUST be 8 years or older. This production is rated 'PG'

<u>Video Auditions:</u> If you are unable to make the general auditions (we strongly recommend an in person audition), a video recorded song that should not exceed 2 minutes may be submitted **before Wednesday, January 31st, 8:30PM** to *selmaartscenter@gmail.com*. Please send via unlisted YouTube link. However, you MUST attend the mandatory callback (*should you be called back*) on Thursday, February 1st at 6:30 PM in order to be considered for a role. If this is not possible, please email selmaartscenter@gmail.com with any questions or concerns.

<u>Callbacks:</u> You will be taught a short combo so come dressed to dance and move. After movement we will proceed into music and scenes. 8-12 year olds will have a separate dance and vocal audition at 6:30PM, all others will be scheduled at 7:30PM. Some auditioners may be released early, however this does not impact your chances of being cast.
