Location: Auditions and Callbacks will take place at **Pioneer Village** - 1880 Art Gonzales Pkwy, Selma CA 93662.

Auditions: Please submit an online <u>Audition Form</u> before signing up for an audition appointment. Performers are welcomed to make an appointment via <u>Sign Up Genius</u>. All performers are encouraged to audition, everyone will be considered for casting for all roles they audition for.

<u>Audition Requirements</u>: Must be over the age of **18**. Please prepare approximately 16-32 bars of music in the style of the show. Please have sheet music or an instrumental track prepared, a bluetooth speaker will be provided.

Video Auditions: If you are unable to make the general auditions (we strongly recommend an in person audition), a video recorded song that should not exceed 2 minutes may be submitted **before April 16th at 8:30pm** to *selmaartscenteauditionsr@gmail.com*. Please send via unlisted YouTube link. However, you MUST attend the mandatory callback (*should you be called back*) on <u>Wednesday</u>, April 17th at 6:30 PM in order to be considered for a role. If this is not possible, please email selmaartscenter@gmail.com with any questions or concerns.

<u>Callbacks</u>: You will be taught a short combo so come dressed to dance and move. After movement we will proceed into music and scenes. Some auditioners may be released early, however this does not impact your chances of being cast.

• Due to the tight rehearsal schedule, <u>all conflicts must be presented during your auditions</u>. Conflicts presented after the first rehearsal will not be honored. Please note that excessive conflicts will affect casting decisions.

- Casting notifications will occur by no later than Saturday, April 20th, 2024.
- Rehearsals for this production will be held Monday through Thursday from 6:30PM-9:30PM, with a Friday rehearsal on the 24th of May.

Synopsis: JERSEY BOYS follows the story of Franky Valli & the Four Seasons. Told through the perspectives of the four main members: Tommy, Bob, NIck, and Franky, the show follows along on their rise to stardom accompanied by the changing of the seasons (get it?). Spring is the first season, Narrated by Tommy, and covers the group's humble(ish) beginnings. Bob takes over in Summer, where the group develops some of their greatest hits and find themselves in love triangles. Act 2 picks up in Fall with Nick, and covers the rougher side of the groups' history, including reasons why they broke up. Finally, Franky takes over in Winter and recounts the band's history after they split up. The group reconvenes for the finale, providing the epilogue for the Jersey Boys.

Roles:

Franky Valli - (20-40, male presenting) a strong tenor with sweet and strong falsetto and be able to sing in the style of Frankie Valli; strong tenor to high A or Bb plus strong falsetto up to treble G; charismatic and charming; have a gritty side as well as a polished veneer; must be very comfortable with traditional four-part harmonies

Tommy DeVito - (20-40, male presenting) a strong tenor/bari-tenor voice; must be very comfortable with traditional four-part harmonies; ability to play guitar a very strong plus; a natural born leader with an appealing, bad-boy quality.

Nick Massi - (20-40, male presenting) a strong bass/baritone voice; must be very comfortable with traditional four-part harmonies; a quiet dreamer who longs for life after The Four Seasons.

Bob Gaudio - (20-40, male presenting) a strong tenor/bari-tenor voice; must be very comfortable with traditional four-part harmonies; an intelligent, sensitive, and introspective musical prodigy.

Joe Pesci - (18-30, male presenting) young, energetic; a good actor and a strong singer. **Bob Crewe** - (20-40, male presenting) intelligent and flamboyant; genius music producer and lyricist; an integral part of creating the magic of The Four Seasons.

Gyp DeCarlo - (30-60, male presenting) tough, mafioso type, good actor and strong singer. **Mary Delgado** - (20-40, female presenting) a strong singer, actor, and dancer; Frankie's wife; tough, "seen it all," Italian, Jersey girl; she's got a killer sense of humor; actor also plays a variety of other roles, including member of a 60s style girl group; strong belt useful; high straight tone soprano also useful but not required.

Lorraine - (20-40, female presenting) versatile actress, singer, and dancer with flexible vocal registers to play a variety of roles (the many girlfriends of The Four Seasons, etc); should fit well

together a la 60s band Shangri-las and be believable as "tough-as-nails" Jersey girls; must be very comfortable with traditional four-part harmonies; must have strong belt.

Francine Valli - (18-30, female presenting) (Same as Above)

Additional Ensemble Roles - (18+) The ensemble consists of various performers, onlookers, officers, and singers that are all woven into the background and forefront of the Four Seasons' journey to stardom; Strong singers, dancers, actors preferred.



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
