Auditions: Please submit an online [Audition Form](#) before signing up for an audition appointment. Performers are welcomed to make an appointment via [Sign Up Genius](#).

Audition Requirements: please prepare approximately 16-32 bars of music in the style of contemporary musical theatre song *as well as* a 1-minute contemporary monologue. Please have sheet music or an instrumental track prepared, a bluetooth speaker will be provided.

Callbacks: Callbacks will be held March 11th 6:30pm at the **Selma Senior Center**. Should you receive a callback, please be prepared to print your own side or have a device to read them on. Printed sides will be limited. You will be taught a short combo so come dressed to dance and move. After movement we will proceed into music and scenes. Some auditioners may be released early, however this does not impact your chances of being cast.

Video Auditions: If you are unable to make the general auditions (we strongly recommend an in person audition), a video recorded song that should not exceed 2 minutes may be submitted **before 03/10/2026 by 8:00 pm** to selmaartscenterauditions@gmail.com. An [Audition Form](#) must be filled out for Video Auditions.

Please send via unlisted YouTube link. However, you **MUST** attend the mandatory callback (*should you be called back*) on **03/11/2026** at 6:30 PM in order to be considered for a role. If this is not possible, please email **STAGE MANAGER EMAIL** with any questions or concerns.

Synopsis: *Grease* is a high-energy musical set at Rydell High in 1959, where slick-haired greaser. Burger Palace Boys and the fierce, fabulous Pink Ladies rule the scene. When cool greaser Danny Zuko reunites with wholesome new girl Sandy Dumbrowski after a summer romance, both must navigate love, reputation, and teenage expectations. All while their classmates sing and dance through the school year. Packed with iconic songs like “Summer Nights,” “Greased Lightnin’,” and “It’s Raining on Prom Night,” *Grease* captures the spirit, style, and sound of the vibrant 1950s in a fast-moving celebration of youth, identity, and rock-and-roll.

AVAILABLE ROLES:

Sandy Dumbrowski - Sweet, wholesome girl who is a new student at Rydell. Danny’s love interest. Must be comfortable with kissing Danny. Must be able to convey the roller coaster of innocence, betrayal, love, and bad-assery of “Big D” in the finale. Dance: Comfortable. Vocal range: Soprano Area

Danny Zuko - Strong, confident, easy-going leader of the Burger Palace Boys. Sandy’s love interest. Must be comfortable with kissing Sandy. Dance: Advanced, must be confident in movement. Vocal range: Baritone/Tenor

Pink Ladies:

Betty Rizzo - Tough, sarcastic, outspoken leader of the Pink Ladies. Kenickie’s love interest. Must be comfortable with kissing Kenickie and being crude with the other Burger Palace Boys. Must be able to convey the vulnerability that Rizzo always hides and only shows once

confronted with pregnancy. Dance: Intermediate. Vocal range: Alto/Mezzo-Soprano , belt is a plus, but not required

Frenchy - Good-natured, a dreamer, and not the sharpest tool in the shed. Member of the Pink Ladies who is heavily interested in how she looks, particularly her hair. Dance: Intermediate. Vocal range: Soprano

Jan - Loud and a compulsive eater. Member of the Pink Ladies who is pushy with the girls, but shy and quiet with the boys. Must be comfortable eating onstage. Dance: Intermediate. Vocal range: Alto/Mezzo-Soprano, belter

Marty - The “beauty” of the Pink Ladies. Seems older but reveals her true age when she starts talking. Must be comfortable with being intimate with Vince Fontaine. Dance: Intermediate. Vocal range: Mezzo-Soprano

Burger Palace Boys:

Kenickie - Tough-looking, surly, second-in-command of the Burger Palace Boys. Has a crude and off-beat sense of humor. Rizzo’s love interest. Must be comfortable with kissing Rizzo. Dance: Intermediate. Vocal range: Baritone

Doody - Boyish, optimistic, and youngest of the Burger Palace Boys. Worships the other guys. Playing guitar is a big plus, but not required. Dance: Intermediate. Vocal range: Tenor

Roger - Mischievous, anything-for-a-laugh, clown of the Burger Palace Boys who enjoys putting others on. Dance: intermediate. Vocal range: Tenor, belter

Sonny - Wheeler-dealer, braggart, member of the Burger Palace Boys who thinks he’s a real lady-killer. Dance: intermediate. Vocal range: Baritone/Tenor

Other Roles:

Sonny - Wheeler-dealer, braggart, member of the Burger Palace Boys who thinks he’s a real lady-killer. Dance: intermediate. Vocal range: Baritone/Tenor

Patty Simcox - Aggressive, catty, all-American cheerleader who is obsessed with Danny. Twirling baton is a plus, but not required. Dance: intermediate with specialty in cheer. Vocal range: flexible.

Eugene - Pompous, awkward, and gullible. Often picked on by the Burger Palace Boys but goes on to become the valedictorian and very successful. Dance: minimal. Vocal range: flexible.

Cha-Cha Digregorio - Loud-mouth and messy dancer. Prides herself on being “the best dancer at St. Bernadette’s.” Dance: Advanced. Vocal range: flexible.

Miss Lynch - Older, rule-enforcing, and stern English teacher. Dance: Minimal. Vocal range: flexible

Vince Fontaine - Generic teen-focused radio host. Fast-talking and a veteran “greaser”. Must be comfortable with being intimate with Marty. Dance: Minimal. Vocal range: flexible.

Johnny Casino - A “greaser” at Rydell that fronts a small Rock and Roll band. Thinks of himself as a real rock star. Dance: Minimal. Vocal range: G4 - E5, sings “Born to Hand Jive”

Teen Angel - Good-looking, Fabian-esque, figment of Frenchy’s imagination. Would’ve caused girls to lose their minds back in 1958. Any age. Dance: minimal. Vocal range: E4 - F5, sings “Beauty School Dropout”

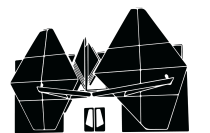
Ensemble - Will make up the other students of Rydell. Will also appear as mechanics and angel chorus. Dance: Intermediate - Advanced
